Engage a whole school approach to planning, assessing, teaching and reporting using the Australian Curriculum Version 8.


- Increase the percentage of all students meeting NAPLAN National Minimum Standards (NMS) in Year 3, 5, 7, 9 to 100% of students achieving NMS in Writing and Reading in Year 3,5, 7, 9 NAPLAN tests
- Increase the percentage of all students achieving Upper 2 Bands (U2B) in Reading and Writing in Year 3, 5, 7, 9 NAPLAN tests
- 100% of students articulating and achieving personal writing and Reading goals each term.
- Improve Student Attainment – A-E
 - 100% of students achieving a C or better in English, Maths and Science
 - Increased percentage (compared to 2019 data) of students achieving an A or a B in English, Maths or Science
 - Every student accessing a different year level curriculum (that is, with an Individual Curriculum Plan) will achieve a C standard or better against relevant year level achievement standard.

Our initiatives includes

- Building teacher capability in delivering the Australian Curriculum Version 8 using a Planning Process and Moderation Process.
- Provide planned and focused intensive teaching to those students requiring additional support to demonstrate achievement against year level achievement standards.
- Continue to develop a whole school approach to teaching Literacy across all subject areas.
- Develop a whole school approach to Early Intervention, which includes using the Speech Pathologist.

Our school will improve student outcomes by

- Providing planning time for teachers to follow a School Planning Process and work together collaboratively to deliver our Literacy foci as a part of our Curriculum delivery. **\$13 440**
- Provide time for teachers to receive feedback from colleagues, Principal and Head of Curriculum
- Using School Speech Pathologist to support programs of intervention. **\$1754**
